# MISSIONARY OF THE MONTH December 2020

# JOSHUA & GINA RIEGER JACKSON, RILEY, RUTHERFORD MISSION TO THE WORLD (MTW) HEXHAM, ENGLAND



Joshua was the Officer-in-charge of Recruiting for the US Navy in South Carolina when he met Gina. They married and at the end of his tour moved to Jackson, Mississippi where he finished seminary and served first as an intern and then on staff at First Presbyterian Church. It was during his time at First Presbyterian that Joshua developed relationships with missionaries in the United Kingdom. God used those relationships to call him into church planting in Hexham, about 20 miles south of the Scottish border.

Less than 2% of the population in England attend an evangelical church, and in Northern England where Hexham is located the number is closer to 0.25%. Joshua's vision and ministry is to see confessional Presbyterian churches raised up in Northern England and indigenous men trained to minister the gospel. To this end he serves in two roles: church planting minister of Hexham Presbyterian Church and Dean of Students for Westminster Presbyterian Theological Seminary, a seminary being developed in Newcastle-upon-Tyne. His church planting efforts began in 2013 and led to the establishment of The Hexham Presbyterian Church in 2015. The Bible study group of 18-20 grew into a congregation now averaging 35-40 on any given Sunday. The church is a member of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church in England and Wales, and Joshua is a PCA minister and a member of the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley.

Joshua and Gina have three children, Jackson, age 10, Riley, age 8, and Rutherford, age 6. Currently, Joshua and Gina are living in the Houston area as Gina receives cancer treatment.

**Prayer Needs:** Pray for **Joshua** as he works remotely with the church plant. Pray for **Gina** as she receives cancer treatments. Pray for their **children** as they are away from their home for a time.
