Reflect on the following bible verses:

1 Chronicles 16:8-11

⁸Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done. ⁹Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts. ¹⁰Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice. ¹¹Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always.

Philippians 4:6-7

⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything, by prayer and supplication with gratitude, make your requests known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will protect your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

1 John 5:13-14

¹³ I have written these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God. ¹⁴ This is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. ¹⁵ So if we know that He hears whatever we ask, we know that we have whatever we asked of Him.

Reflect on the following bible verse:

Ephesians 3:20 "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to the power that is at work within us...".

God is immeasurably more than we can ever imagine. His love is immeasurably more than we can fathom. His abundance is immeasurably more than we could ever ask for. God's ability to act in and through us is far greater and more abundant than anything we can understand. This power enables us to accomplish the great things that He has already planned for us. It encourages us to trust Him, and to step out in faith, knowing that He can accomplish all things to further His kingdom.

Heavenly Father,

Reflect on these bible verses:

Colossians 2:6-7

⁶So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

Jeremiah 17:7-8

⁷ "But blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him. ⁸ They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

Being "rooted in faith" signifies a deep and unwavering trust and commitment to God and His Son, Jesus Christ. It reminds us that faith is not a superficial or fleeting idea, but a core principle that shapes our lives. It means that God is our source of strength. His "roots" go deep into our souls, providing comfort, peace, love, and guidance during every season of life. Reflect on these bible verses:

Psalm 24:1-2

¹The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; ² for he founded it on the seas and established it on the waters.

1 Chronicles 29:11-13

¹¹Yours, LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, LORD, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. ¹² Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. ¹³ Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name.

Ephesians 5:19b-20

¹⁹...... sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, ²⁰ always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Reflect on these bible verses:

Proverbs 3:9-10:

⁹ Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; ¹⁰ then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

Luke 6:38

³⁸ Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

Matthew 6:19-21

¹⁹ "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Reflect on the following bible verses:

Jeremiah 29:11:

 11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Philippians 1:9-11:

⁹And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, ¹⁰ so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.
