- 3. In your own family, what has been the significance of feasting at family gatherings? How does the act of eating together promote fellowship and community? How is that also true for us all in the Lord's Supper?
- 4. Jesus describes the kingdom of heaven as a banquet in Luke 14:16-24. In Luke 22:16 and 18, Jesus promises his disciples that he will "eat [this meal] again" and "drink again from the fruit of the vine" with them in his Father's kingdom. What does this idea—of not simply being fully in the presence of Jesus, but also having him eat and drink anew with us—suggest to you about the extent of fellowship with God that awaits us? Have you ever thought much about heaven as a feast both with God's people and with Jesus himself? What ideas come to your mind as you envision that feast?


