Reflection questions:

1. What is one of your earliest memories? What are some of your deepest and most powerful memories? Why do you think those memories have stayed with you the way they have?
2. The feast of Passover is about remembering how God delivered his people from slavery in Egypt. Stunningly, Jesus reinterprets Passover in light of himself. What parallels exist between Luke 22:7-20 and Exodus 12:1-42? What has Communion meant to you individually and to the communities you've been in, and how does it help us remember what Jesus has done for us?
3. In your own family, what has been the significance of feasting at family gatherings? How does the act of eating together promote fellowship and community? How is that also true for us all in the Lord's Supper?
4. Jesus describes the kingdom of heaven as a banquet in Luke 14:16-24. In Luke 22:16 and 18, Jesus promises his disciples that he will "eat [this meal] again" and "drink again from the fruit of the vine" with them in his Father's kingdom. What does this idea—of not simply being fully in the presence of Jesus, but also having him eat and drink anew with us—suggest to you about the extent of fellowship with God that awaits us? Have you ever thought much about heaven as a feast both with God's people and with Jesus himself? What ideas come to your mind as you envision that feast?
5. Passover commemorated the defining story for God's people Israel. What is our defining story as Christians? How does what Jesus says and does in Luke 22:14-20 relate to or communicate that defining story and the hope that God gives us through it?

How I can respond in faith today: Think about what happens during Communion—the words spoken, the gestures used by the pastor, the movements made (like coming forward to receive). In what ways does this part of worship draw you into the presence of God?
