Ministry Focus:

DESCRIBE THE SCOPE OR INTENT OF THE MINISTRY.

Kenya has 22 unreached tribes. GGFAN is working in 5 of these : Samburu, Pokot, Turkana, Ilchamus, Rendille and making initial engagements with other unreached tribes. Since 2012, GGFAN has partnered with Faith Ventures Foundation-USA and Samburu County Nkalup Vision (SCNV) which represents 20 of the larger denominations in Samburu County, to train almost around 800 new and existing pastors, who have planted 839 churches and preaching points. In collaboration with Bible Literacy & Translation and Faith Ventures Foundation-USA, 800 copies of the Samburu New Testament, dedicated in December 2019, have been distributed to Nkalup Pastors. In partnership with St. Michael's Anglican Church, Charleston, Bill Johnson of Faith Ventures Inc Canton started funding Samburu Children pre-school education program in 2018 which currently has 17 pre-schools supported with weekly lunch food and stipend for the 17 teachers. St. Michael's Anglican Church Charleston and Faith Ventures Foundation-USA have given grants to build 101 churches (mostly 15' x 30' buildings) for worship, medical dispensary, and pre-schools. St. Michael's and Faith Ventures have helped SCNV serve 651,381 meals(feeding over 21,700 people) since June, 2020 due to the famine from locust infestation, Covid-19 pandemic and years of a worst drought due to failed rains.

Strategies for Sharing the Gospel in this Ministry:

DESCRIBE THE APPROACH USED TO SHARE THE GOSPEL THROUGH THIS MINISTRY.

- Empower indigenous leaders to reach their own people by ministry
- Train existing denominational leaders how to plant new Preaching Points in remote areas
- Stipend Preaching Point Leaders (PPLs) for 3 years until their congregation is self-sufficient
- Construct church buildings when worship attendance exceeds the shadow of an acacia tree
- Disciple new converts using orality-based media (One Message TV Samburu stories, Jesus Film, etc.)
- Reproduce disciples by studying from new Samburu New Testament (Dec. 2019 1st edition)
- Improve Literacy by supporting the 17 Pre-School Teachers and providing food for children lunch.

Financial Needs:

- \$500 per session to train denominational leaders and PPLs (3 per year to train 150 leaders per year)
- \$100 monthly provide a stipend for a teacher for 50 pre-school children to prepare them for 1st grade
- \$300 monthly to sponsor 10 PPLs for 3 years as they plant 30 new churches
- \$300 monthly to operate 12 motorbikes for Coordinators to visit/ disciple 750 PPLs in remote areas.
- \$2,000 to build a 15' x 30' iron sheet building for worship, medical dispensary & school.
- \$40,000 each from 5 partners to construct the Nkalup-GGFAN Training Center in Maralal
