Ministry Focus:

Guide and shape future Anglican leaders from around the world toward their full potential. Encourage theological education for young clergy around the Anglican Communion.

Strategies for Sharing the Gospel in this Ministry:

Leadership Development.

ALI offers men and women with a proven track of ministry a chance to spend a month in community under the guidance of expert leaders who have exercised faithful and effective ministry in their own contexts. Together, they explore issues of poverty, freedom, persecution and faith in the modern world. Participants attend lectures on leadership, dig into case studies addressing situations like “human trafficking” and “honor killings,” and learn about the causes of poverty and what can be done about it.

Global Pandemic.

The impact of the Global Pandemic issues and related restrictions has caused the ALI to delay it’s next session until the Fall of 2021.

Financial Needs:

Participants receive coverage from ALI for travel, visa, training and residential expenses, as well as any other out-of-pocket costs during the retreat. The average coverage cost for each participant is \$9,300.

Total amount needed to sustain this Ministry: \$270,000 USD per year.
