Presented below are the primary **C.A.R.E.** Ministry services offered at St. Michael's, accompanied by specific methods for contacting **C.A.R.E.** regarding assistance.

Core **CARE** Ministry Offerings:

1. **Pastoral C.A.R.E.** - Prayer /Prayer appointments, Home, Hospital Visits
2. **Scribes for Christ** - Encouraging and loving personal notes and cards
3. **Cooks for Christ** - Preparation and Delivery of Meals
4. **Wheels for Christ** - Transportation for shut-ins who may need medicine, groceries and those who may need a ride to church.

Methods for C.A.R.E. Assistance:

1. Fill out a pew **C.A.R.E.** card and put in the offering plate at any one of our Sunday services.
2. Call the Church office
3. Call me personally at [843-860-5124] or connect with any one of our **C.A.R.E.** Team Members you may know.
4. Let your clergy know and they will reach out to **C.A.R.E.**
