Urgent Help Needed for Emergency Relief in Honduras

HURRICANES ETA AND IOTA

Just two weeks after Hurricane Eta brought widespread flooding in Honduras, the country was battered by Hurricane Iota. In the wake of these two back-to-back hurricanes, the destruction seen is being described as one of the worst in the nation's history. Official government channels are reporting that more than 3,000,000 people have been impacted. Hundreds of thousands have evacuated and tens of thousands are in shelters.

The situation hasn't been heavily covered by national media and many people are unaware of the need. Therefore, Water Mission is calling on the local church and the generous people in the Charleston area to help meet the needs in our rescue, response, and recovery efforts.
