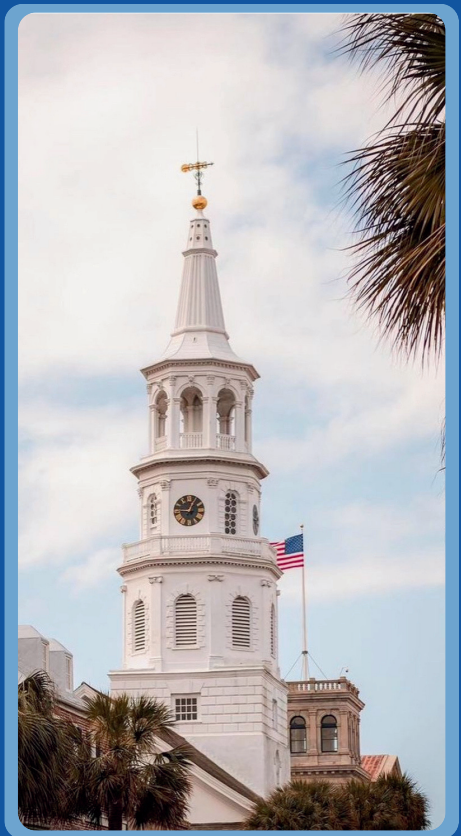
About Us

STEP 1: ALPHA

The Alpha Course is a series of talks based on the most often asked questions of Christianity, such as:

- Why did Jesus die?
- Who is Jesus?
- Does Evil exist?

Alpha is also about bringing people around you in a small group that can be your small group for the rest of your life!

STEP 2: “I Like Mike” Newcomer’s Class

I Like Mike is a course about what it means to be Anglican and the history of St. Michael’s.

STEP 4: Small Groups

It is our hope that the group you were in, in Alpha, will become a small group where you will study the disciplines of discipleship, from Scripture to the spiritual gifts and become active in our outreach ministries to transform hearts in the home, holy city, hurting coast and hungering world.





Super Wednesday



Super Wednesday focuses on worship, fellowship and equipping. Each Wednesday at 10 am we host a worship service in the Belser Chapel suitable for all ages. In the afternoon, we offer homeschool programs for children in K-12th grade, providing activities and enrichment opportunities for the local homeschool community. Additionally, our children's choir, which includes members from ages 4-5th grade, holds practice sessions.



Evenings are dedicated to fellowship and equipping, beginning with a family dinner at 5:30 pm. Following the dinner, our classes begin at 6:30 pm and continue until 7:30 pm. We provide various classes in the Fall and Spring for adults, youth and children, including a nursery for ages 6 weeks to 3 years. The Adult classes vary each session, focusing on biblically grounded teachings and align with our primary focus of transforming hearts through Jesus Christ. During this time, our adult choir also meets for practice and always welcomes new participants.
