



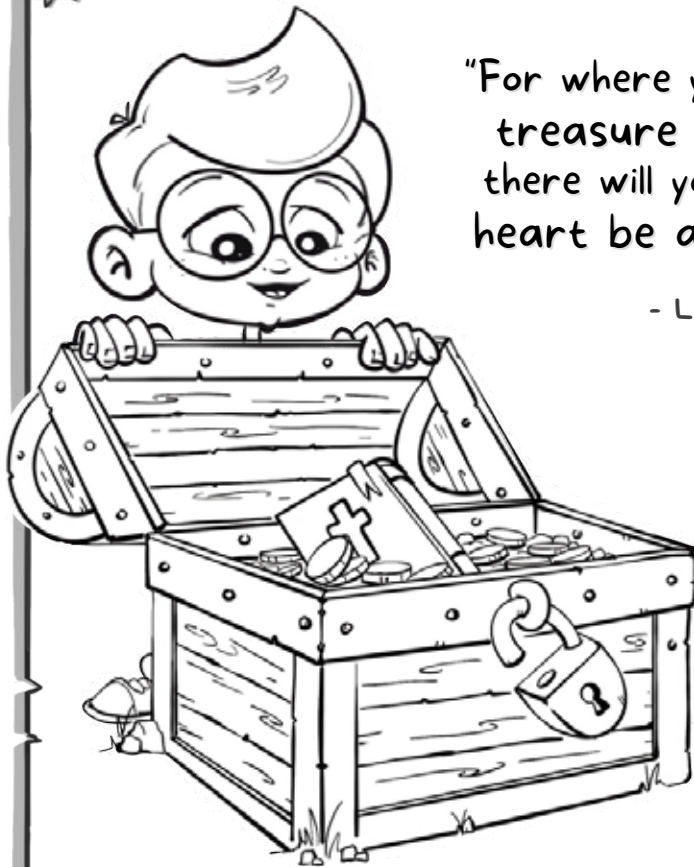

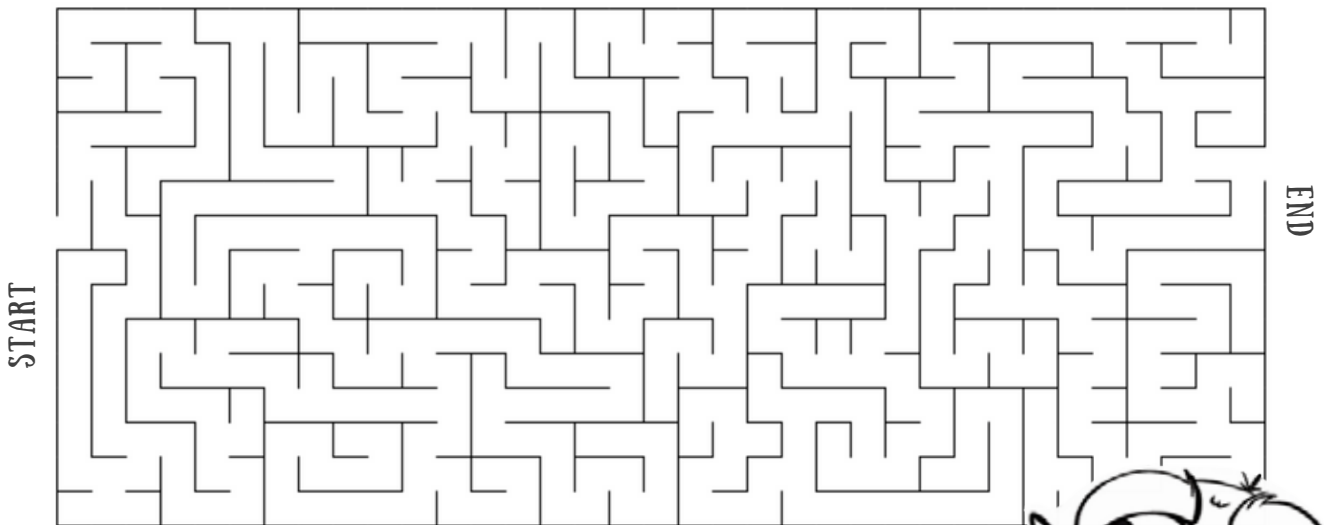
Today we get to hear about

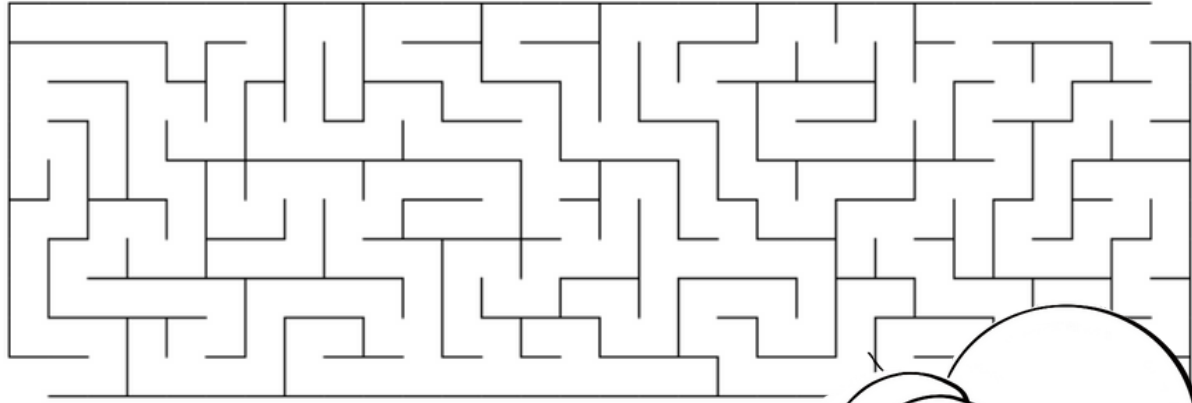

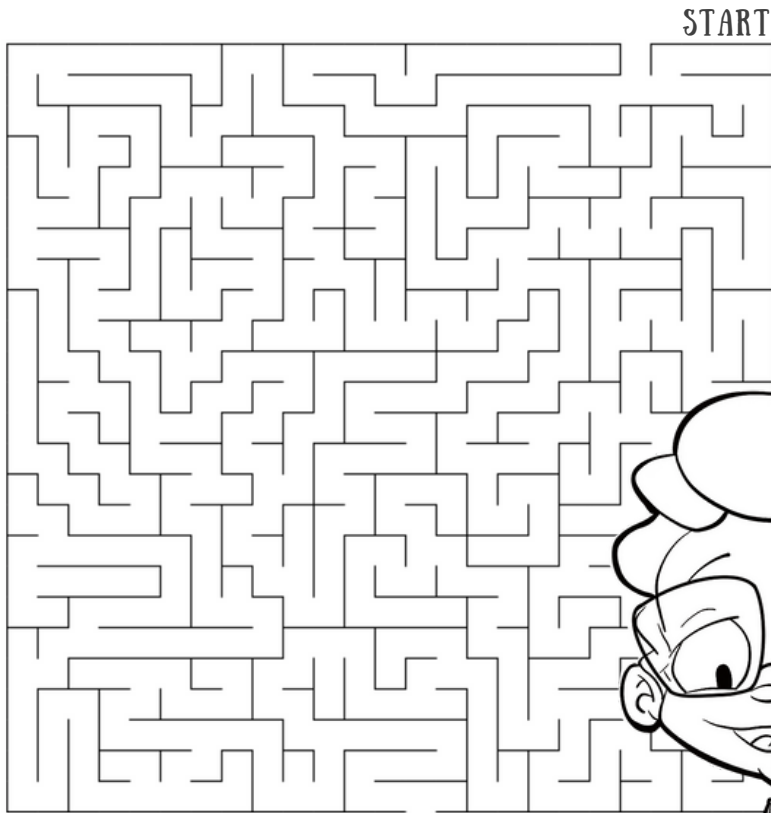

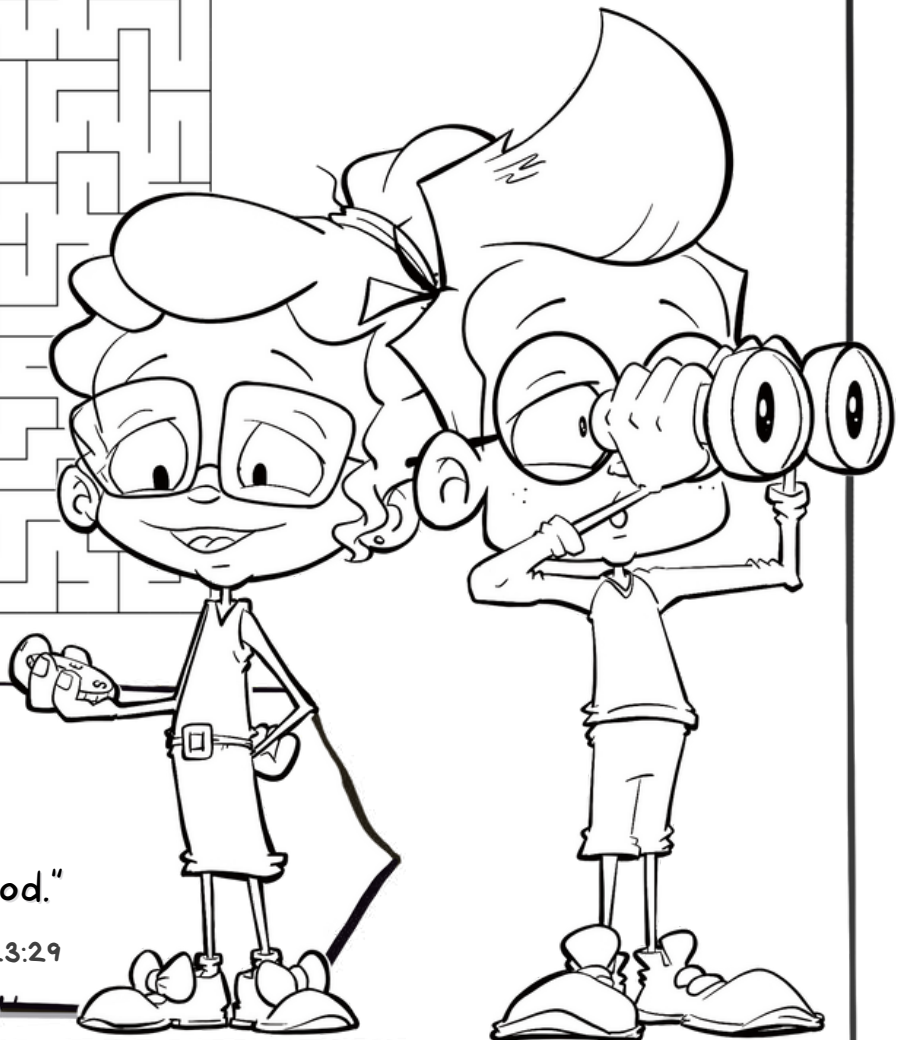
Hebrews 12:4-29 gives encouragement during hard times.

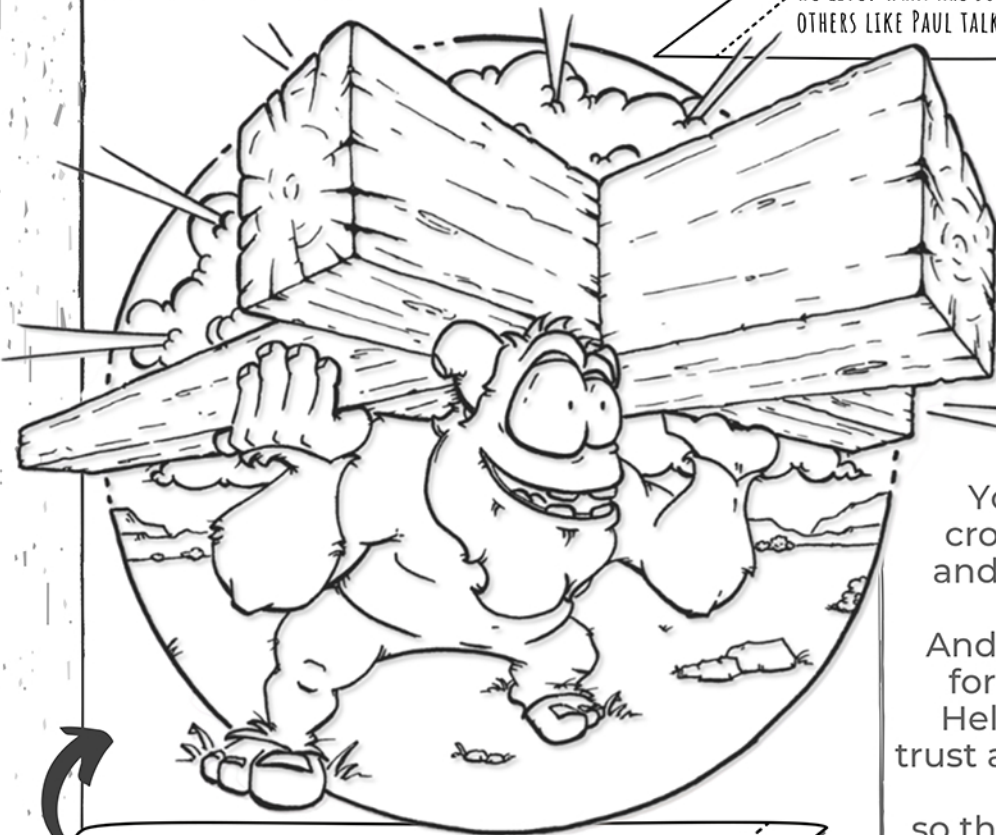
In our gospel reading Jesus tells of His coming death and resurrection. He then tells his disciples to take up their cross and follow Him.
