#### **Church Rental**

In November, we were approached by Dan Cooke and Doug Hoven, members of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church from Wakefield, VA, to rent space from our church. This Church is a branch of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church in Virginia Beach. The Wakefield Church currently meets in the home of Doug Hoven. They have grown to 60 members and it is becoming hard for them to meet in a home. These two young men found our building by riding around the Suffolk area. It is their hope to plant a new church in Suffolk. After personally meeting these two fine young men, we knew that again the Lord was working in our church. It reminded us of a Chapter of the "Hopeful Imagination" book we studied back in the Spring.

After many discussions and meetings, the Board of Deacons and the House of Worship Committee felt this partnership would work. We have addressed their needs and our insurance liability. On Sunday, December 18, 2022, these two boards made a recommendation to the Executive Board to contract with the Orthodox Presbyterian Church to rent a portion of our Building. The Executive Board has approved this agreement. The Church will use the Baraca Room and Fellowship Hall on Sunday afternoons from 2:00 PM until 6:00 PM. We are in the process of finalizing the contract which will be effective around the middle of January. Once this is complete, anyone is welcome to review the contents. If you have any questions, please ask Evelyn Jones, Jim Goben or Alan Garner. We want everyone to know the details so don't hesitate to ask questions. It will be great to see our building opened more often.
