The Board of Deacons Reports.....from the April 12th, 2023 Meeting

- *An open session was held prior to the meeting and ten people (non-board members) attended, expressing concerns and/or offering comments.
- *The Board voted to hold similar open sessions on a quarterly basis, giving each participant five minutes to voice concerns and/or offer suggestions. As always, all meetings are open to any member wanting to attend (except for Executive Session) but if someone wishes to speak at a regular meeting, they should contact the chair so it can be included on the agenda. All concerns and suggestions will receive full review by the Board.
- *It was decided that a report on each meeting would be published in the monthly newsletter to better inform the congregation of important matters of the church.
- *Because of the great blessing of an accumulated large amount of money that's been given to our church to feed the hungry, the Board voted to change the name of this important mission from "Food Pantry" to "Food Ministries." This in no way affects our Tuesday afternoon food give-away, but other avenues to help feed the hungry in our community will be sought. If you have an idea or suggestion for a food ministry please bring it to any member of the Board.
- *The Board acknowledged and thanked Tommy Queen for his long-term personal ministry providing meals every other month at the Salvation Army, with the help of several of our church members. This ministry will now be an SCC mission and fall under the "Food Ministries" umbrella.
- *Reviewing the SCC constitution is ongoing but nearing completion. When completed and approved by the Board, it will 'lay on the table' for 90 days, giving everyone a chance to review the revised document before it is put before a church conference for vote.
- *A church member has generously donated a full page ad in a publication of the Holland Ruritan Club so that information about our church can be shared with those attending the Car Show (May 13) and the annual Founders Day events (May 20). Thank you to this anonymous donor.
- *The monthly mission for May will be "Tornado and Storm Relief."




