The Theme of Our Conference is

The Preaching Ministry in a Lutheran Parish

Based on 2 Timothy 4:1-2

"I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.

Introduction: The sainted church father, John Chrysostom, wrote in his work *Six Books on the Priesthood* that part of the craft of preaching involves the necessity for evaluating one's work. "Let the best craftsman be the judge of his own handiwork," Chrysostom counseled. Yet, like most words of wisdom, Chrysostom's counsel is easier said than done.

The responsibility of preaching is an ongoing commitment. It requires a pastor to evaluate his craft in preaching lest he falls into bad habits or becomes complacent and loses the reverent awe of the unique privilege of stepping into the pulpit as Christ's messenger. The pastor communicates God's promises in Christ Jesus to the congregation and the community through preaching. While it may be a weekly obligation, pastors seldom have the opportunity to take a step back and contemplate the broader role of preaching and engage in ongoing preparation for this duty.

This year's conference presents an exceptional opportunity to gain insights from Rev. Dr. Samuel Zumwalt of St. Matthew's Lutheran, Wilmington, NC, who will delve into the craft of preaching within the Lutheran tradition. His sessions will take a fresh and practical approach to understanding the profound responsibility of Christian preaching, encouraging pastors to refine their skills, reflect on the distinct privilege of proclaiming the message of Christ and Him crucified, and provide a new and refreshing approach to sermon preparation for Sunday services.
