The School

Triad Baptist Christian Academy is a ministry started in 2003 by Triad Baptist Church. The school's desire is to partner with parents in the teaching and training of their children. The Academy adheres to the statutory standards of the state of North Carolina and holds a Notice of Compliance from the NC Department of Non-Public Education. The school serves students in the town of Kernersville and the surrounding Triad area of North Carolina. The school is culturally diverse with a population of 83% Caucasian, 10% African American, 7% other minority students. The high school day consists of rotating block schedule. Seven credits per year is the maximum class load. TBCA partners with the local colleges to provide dual enrollment for juniors and seniors who qualify. The grades from these classes are recognized for graduation, and included in the GPA for students. Honors and AP classes are offered.

Grade point average (GPA) is based on a 4.0 scale, with the exception that honors courses receive 0.5 point and Dual Enrollment College Courses and AP classes receive additional points. All high school courses are included in the calculation of GPA. If a student enters TBCA with credits from another high school, the credits from the previous school will be noted on the TBCA transcript with remarks of where they were received and the grading scale information. Those grades are included in the TBCA cumulative GPA calculation. Transcripts are updated in June at the conclusion of each academic year.
