GPA Calculation

Grade point average (GPA) is based on a 4.3 scale, with the exception that honors courses receive 0.5 point and Dual Enrollment College Courses and AP classes receive additional points. All high school courses are included in the calculation of GPA. If a student enters TBCA with credits from another high school, the credits from the previous school will be noted on the TBCA transcript with remarks of where they were received and the grading scale information. Those grades are included in the TBCA cumulative GPA calculation. Transcripts are updated in June at the conclusion of each academic year.
