**Preparation:** Plan a family outing to the zoo or some place where you can hike along a trail in the woods. If you can't do either of these, plan an evening around PBS or a video with a lot of wildlife footage. Bring along a Bible, paper, and pencils (or crayons if you have kids who are too young to write).

Theme Verse: Genesis 1:1

Family Time: After you have taken your trip through the zoo or along the trail, sit down with your family at a picnic table and ask each person to write (or draw) their response to the following:

What was your favorite creature and why? Describe the ugliest creature. (Don't tell anyone what it is.) What was the most interesting thing you saw and what was so interesting about it?

Have each person respond to the first question. Then ask them to describe the ugliest creature and see if anyone else can guess what it is. Next, read the creation story in Genesis chapters 1 and 2. Read it fast, and focus on the amazing miracle of creation itself. Be careful not to get caught up in too many facts. Help your children marvel at the miracle and greatness of it all. Reinforce the truth of creation as a fact and not a myth or story. Since your kids will be returning to school in a couple of weeks, now is a good time to highlight the difference between creation and evolution. It is

important for Christians to believe man was image for the purpose of having a created in God's relationship with God. Your kids need to know they are of God's hand. Finish your a special, creative work discussion by giving your children a chance to ask questions respond to the creation story.

To close your devotion, have each child pray. In their prayer, have them give God thanks for what they found most interesting and for creating us and this magnificent earth we live on.


