What is a Weekday CIRCLE?

A Weekday CIRCLE is a group of 8–14 people who meet weekly to study God's Word, pray together, serve, and build meaningful relationships.

Who are they for?

CIRCLES are open to adults in all life stages—Singles, Young Families, Parents of Kids (K–5), Parents of Teens, Empty Nesters, Senior Adults, and Multi-Generational groups.

How do I choose a Weekday CIRCLE?

Select a group based on its leader/host team and life stage. These categories help you find a good fit but don't limit your options—you're free to explore.

How long do they last?

Each session runs 8–12 weeks. At the end, you can stay in the same group, try another, or take a break.

What will we study?

Most groups follow sermon review questions (SRQs) based on the Sunday morning message. Some do book studies, while others share devotions and prayer time.

What about childcare?

CIRCLES are for adults only (exceptions for nursing newborns). Families arrange their own childcare—some groups share a sitter by agreement.

What if my season of life changes?

Groups are flexible—you can change groups if your needs or life stage shift.

WHERE FAITH AND COMMUNITY COME FULL CIRCLE

Circles are our Sunday School and small group communities at Triad Baptist Church—places where faith grows deeper, friendships grow stronger, and lives are transformed by Jesus Christ.

A Circle is more than a class or meeting. It's a gathering where you can belong, be known, and become more like Christ alongside others on the same journey.

In a Circle, you'll:

- Build relationships beyond Sunday morning
- Study God's Word and apply it to real life
- Pray with and for each other
- Encourage spiritual growth through honest conversation and accountability

The early church modeled this kind of fellowship:

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." — Acts 2:42

The name Circles reflects both our mission and our design—multiple, interconnected circles representing eternal life, wholeness, and spiritual growth. Whether on Sunday mornings or during the week, Circles connect people to Jesus, one another, and meaningful service.

We offer a wide variety of Circles for every life season and interest so everyone can find a place to grow in faith and live out their calling in community.
