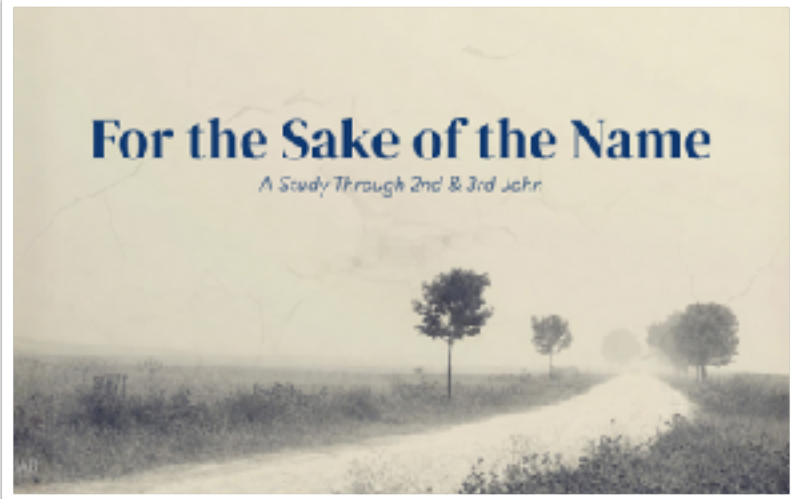
If you know of someone new to our church who may be interested in church membership, our First Steps class just started and they can register by calling the church office this week.
