Scripture Passage: Exodus 2:11-15, 3:1-8, 13-14 Sermon Title: "Stuck in the Middle"

Acclimation: What is your all-time favorite movie and why?

Interpretation:

Read Exodus 2:11-15, 3:1-8, 13-14. Without giving thought to the sermon preached on this passage, what is your personal observation of these verses? What themes do you notice?

Consideration:

As you consider the message that was preached, what was the most impactful point that was made? Why do you think this point spoke to you personally? Explain your answer.

Clarification:

Describe something that this message revealed about the character of God, the Person of Jesus, or the ministry of the Holy Spirit? Explain your answer and what you learned in the process.

Confrontation:

Was there a point made in the sermon where you personally disagreed or felt tension and conflict because of a point that was made? Describe how you differ from the speaker's perspective?

Representation:

What is a supporting Biblical principle that was not included in the sermon, but maybe should have been? Explain your rationale for feeling this way.

Application:

What is one point of action that you can implement this week as a result of this passage and the sermon preached?
