Scripture Passage: Exodus 2:11-15, 3:1-8, 13-14

Sermon Title: “Stuck in the Middle”

1. Icebreaker: What is your all-time favorite movie and why?
2. In your spiritual walk, tell about a time when you noticed something on the outside that was a direct reflection of what was going on internally. Explain your answer.
3. Pastor Rob said that “your purpose is shaped by your frustration.” Explain a situation where something you were initially frustrated with prompted you to find purpose in your frustration. What lessons were learned because of times of frustration in your life?

4. When was the last time that you allowed a problem from yesterday destroy your today or tomorrow? What are practical ways to keep this from happening in the future?

5. As you reflect on the calling of God in the life of Moses, what is your personal “burning bush” experience? What has God revealed to you in this experience? Be specific.

6. What is one course of action that you can take this week as a result of something from the sermon?

7. What observation from this week’s sermon did you personally find to be most impactful?
