Bottom Line: Finding Common Ground, Preaching Jesus and Moving

towards the Mess!

INTRODUCTION/BREAKING THE ICE:

Start out with a fun, "guess the song," game for small group bragging rights. Have a contest to see how many people can name these tunes! Use the second page of the guide to pick out your favorites!

UNPACKING THE GOSPEL:

We live in a culture where the Christian faith, worldview, lifestyle, morals, and ethics are not the norm and are becoming less accepted. How should we react to a world, culture, and people who don't share our worldview, morals, ethics, or beliefs?

Read Acts 17:16-18

- 1) Why do you think Paul was provoked to engage the Athenians?
- 2) The culture of Athens promoted the exact opposite of Paul's Christian faith. Paul didn't condemn or run away. Rather he moved toward the mess. What can we learn from how Paul moved toward the Athenians?
- 3) How can you move toward the mess and not run away when engaging someone of a different belief or background?

Read Acts 17:19-34

- 1) Why do you think people wanted to know more about what Paul had to say?
- 2) How can you personally live and speak in such a way that people will want to know more about Jesus?
- 3) One of the ways Paul engaged the Athenians was through finding common ground through their poetry and religious questions. What type of common ground can you find in building a relationship with someone with different views than yours? (surfing, exercise, art, music, hunting, job, etc.)

LIVING OUT THE GOSPEL IN MY EVERYDAY LIFE

- 1) Two values we hold as a church are to be missionally-minded and relational evangelism. What is your role in engaging those around you? (Our job is to engage. God's job is to change hearts. That's a huge relief!)
- 2) What should be your motivation to move towards the mess and engage people? (a. We want to do what God did for us, "While we were sinners..." b. How happy God must be to see us pursue, not retreat in fear. c. Genuine love for people)
- 3) Who in your life do you need to engage? Take time with your small group to pray for these people.
