What did we do today?

What was the Big Idea today?

What Bible passage did we talk about?

In the Gospel of Mark he records a story where some of the disciples were arguing about who among them was the greatest. Jesus' response is incredible and it turns the argument completely on its head. The greatest among them is the one who puts themselves last. The greatest is the servant.

How do we take this & make it stick?

If they wanted to, we gave them the opportunity to sign up to serve on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. We think it is very important for them to begin serving the church, it will give them the opportunity to realize we don't go to church because of what it does for us. Rather church is about what we can do for others. We are all partners with God carrying the good news to everyone. Ask them about where they wanted to serve and why? Encourage them and help them see how they can love on others at church?
