### **UNPACKING THE GOSPEL IN THE BIBLE:**

## Read Exodus 20:14: Matthew 5:27-28

- 1) How does Jesus define adultery?
  - a. Not just an act, but a condition of our hearts.
  - b. Can be as simple as looking at someone with lust.

# 2) What do these passages reveal about why God's created sex?

- a. Procreation sex was meant to be life giving.
- b. Pleasure sex was meant to be enjoyable.
- c. Power meant to unite people in God, identity and trust.

# 3) Why does God love sex between husband and wife?

- a. God loves safety Sex is so powerful, that it can do irreparable damage (Prov. 5:15)
- b. God loves freedom Guilt-free, shane-free sex is the best (Gen. 2:25)
- c. God loves married sex (Matthew 19:4)

## 4) What is it about adultery that breaks the heart of God?

- a. It's painful, destructive, discourages discipleship, idolatry, selfishness, pride, etc.
- b. All of these things are against God's faithfulness and freedom that he offers.

### LIVING OUT THE GOSPEL IN MY EVERYDAY LIFE:

- 1) How does the 7th commandment give as a mirror and a window into who God is?
  - a. Mirror: Reveals that we are all guilty of adultery and in need of a Savior.
  - b. Window: Helps us to see that God is perfectly faithful.
