## THE GOSPEL | GOD'S STORY

God's story is called the Gospel. Gospel simply means good news. The Gospel is the thread that runs throughout the Bible. As a believer, it is our hope, joy, peace, and foundation. It's simple enough for a child, yet profound enough for a theologian. It's what we believe with all our hearts and out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. It can be summarized in 4 simple parts: God, Man, Jesus, Response. It goes something like this...

### GOD | ROMANS 1:18-20

The eternal God of the universe simply spoke the universe into creation. Man and woman were at the height of his creation and were made to have a relationship with him and to glorify God as his image bearers.

### MAN | ROMANS 1:21-23, 3:23, 6:23

But man and woman sinned when they thought they could be like God by eating fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Since then, all mankind has inherited the sinful nature of their parents as it's passed down, not to mention sinned themselves.

### JESUS | ROMANS 3:23-26, 5:8-10, 8:1

But God promised he would make a way for man to be forgiven since the first sin and he fulfilled his promise through Jesus, the Son of God. He left heaven for earth on the greatest mission ever. He was born without sin by the virgin Mary, lived a perfect sinless life, died in our place and took the punishment for our sin, but rose from the dead, overcoming the power of sin and death, and ascended back into heaven with God where he awaits the time when he will return to bring all those who have believed to be with him in heaven.

### RESPONSE | ROMANS 10:9-13

God will save all who have called out to him and responded in repentance and faith in this good news, this gospel. We know that we don't deserve it and we know we can't earn it! Yet God made this good news known to us. Upon hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ and having received his grace and forgiveness, we repent of our sins and believe on Jesus Christ alone for our salvation. We were graciously given new life in Christ, born again, and made into a new creation and thus we have responded in faith and committed ourselves to follow Jesus all the days of our life.

### SIMPLE VERSION

**GOD** spoke the universe into creation and specially made man in his image. But the first **MAN** and every man sinned against God and broke our relationship forever. But God sent **JESUS** from heaven to earth to die in our place so sin would be punished but we might be saved. Then Jesus rose from the dead and returned to heaven to prepare a place for those who would **RESPOND** in faith. By believing in this good news you can be saved by grace through faith.

## MY TESTIMONY | MY STORY

When God's story, the Gospel, changes your life, it becomes your story. Your story is sometimes called a testimony as you share how you came to believe God's story and how it impacted your life. Your story has 4 main parts: My story before Jesus, God's story in Jesus, God's Story became my story, and My story with Jesus. Your story should be flexible enough to share in 1 minute with a stranger or 1 hour over coffee with a friend. Be ready to share your testimony with the elders.

### MY STORY BEFORE JESUS

Share some details about your life before you became a believer. If you were saved out of a rough background full of sin and hard times, don't focus too much on details as we want to give most of the attention to Jesus. If you were truly saved at an early age then you may not have much to focus on here. Simply describe your life and acknowledge you knew you had sinned against God and were far from him.

### GOD'S STORY IN JESUS

Then insert your simple version of God's Story as this is your opportunity to share the Gospel with those you are talking with. Give them what Paul said was most important...Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose on the third day. (1 Corinthians 15:3-4 ESV)

## GOD'S STORY BECAME MY STORY

Now share how and when you responded to the grace of Jesus by faith and belief in the Gospel. Give some detail about how old you were, where you were at, and what was happening in your life at that time. Make sure you focus on how God saved you based on what He did, not anything that you did.

## MY STORY WITH JESUS

There should be some dramatic changes from your life before faith in Jesus and your life with faith in Jesus. Share about some of those areas and give God the glory. Don't give a false representation that all your fears, temptations, problems, and sin are gone. Be honest about the difficulties of living by faith, but share the hope you have in Christ to overcome those difficulties. Describe what it looks like for you to grow as you follow Christ.
