## Date 1 John 1 (ESV)

**Sep 15** <sup>1</sup> That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life

**Sep 22** <sup>2</sup> the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us—

**Sep 29** <sup>3</sup> that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.

**Oct 6** <sup>4</sup> And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

**Oct 13** <sup>5</sup> This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

**Oct 20** <sup>6</sup> If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

**Oct 27** <sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

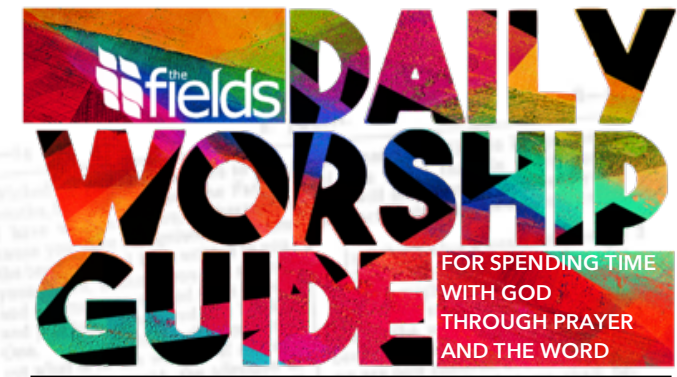
**Nov 3** <sup>8</sup> If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

**Nov 10** <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

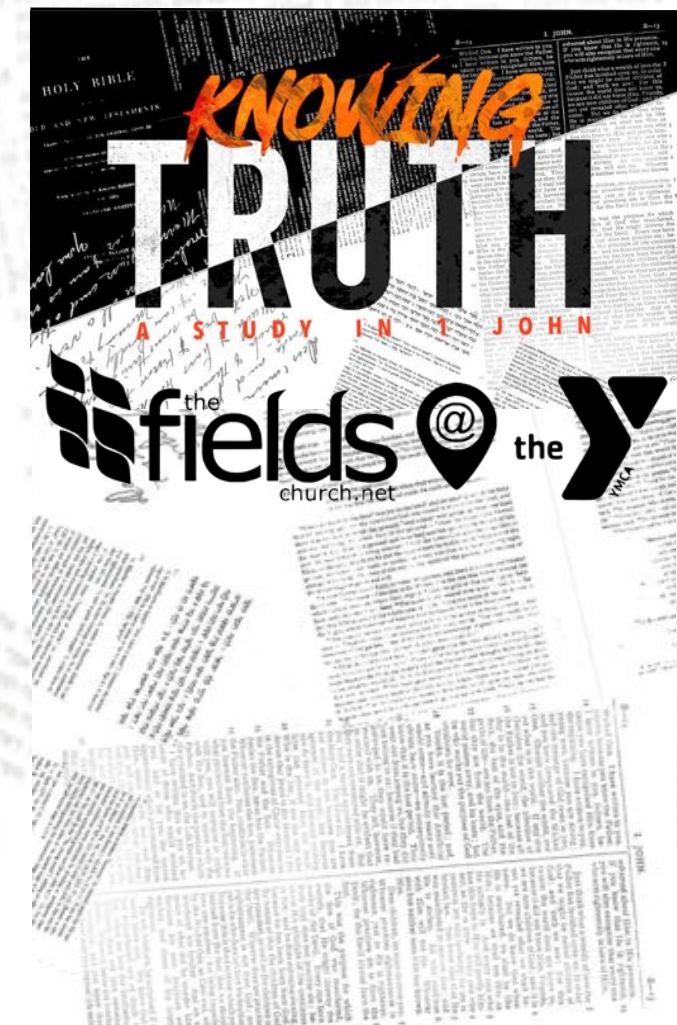
**Nov 17** <sup>10</sup> If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

# Reading Guide

## →PRAY Preparation (Ez. 8:23)

Thank God for speaking to us and revealing himself in his Word (2 Timothy 3:16, Hebrews 4:12). Ask God to help you understand so that you might know him and make him known!

- What sort of writing is this? (Historical/Narrative, Sermon/Letter, Poem/Song, Prophetic/Apocalyptic)
- What is the context or circumstance surrounding your reading? (Time period, Author, Addressee)

## →READ Observation (Neh. 8:1-8)

*What does it say?*

- What sticks out and surprises you in this text?
- What repetition, key words, commands, characters, or climax did you observe?
- What's the main focus and emphasis of the text?

## →STUDY Interpretation (Ez. 7:10)

*What did it mean for them?*

- What did you learn about God and the Gospel?
- What did you learn about yourself and the world?
- What questions do you have?

## →DO Application (Ez. 7:10)

*What does it mean for you?*

- How might you sum up your reading in your own words?
- What wrong beliefs and actions do you need to repent and confess?
- What do you need to believe and do in response to God's Word?

## →TEACH Multiplication (Ez. 7:10)

*What does it mean for others?*

- What can you share with another Christian to encourage them to follow Christ?
- What can you share with a Non-Christian so they might consider following Christ?
