S	ermon Application
1.	In Community groups, our typical practice is to discuss the text from the sermon. This way, you'll have a chance to discuss and apply to your lives Sunday's sermon. Read about <i>Peter's profession</i> in Matthew 16:13-17 and ask your leader to share when they first <i>professed</i> (became a Christian). (Hot seat for the leaderhaha!)
2.	Upon Peter's profession, he was given the "Keys of the kingdom"authority to proclaim the message of Jesus. This same authority is entrusted to the people of God (Rom 10:17). How is this task humbling to you?
3.	The "Keys of the kingdom is also the authority of the church to "bind" (Mt 16:19). Through baptism and membership into local churches, we recognize credible professions of faith and walk alongside them in the local church. Why would this be important?
