Sunday, March 1st | 2 Chronicles "Revival" 2 Chronicles 34-35

- [2] 2 Chron 34:1-13 I Describe Josiah's character. List some of the things he did that revealed that he was seeking the Lord. What verse summarizes his life at that time & would have been a good epitaph on his gravestone?
- [3] 2 Chron 34:1-13 I What were some of the obstacles that Josiah had to overcome? What obstacles do Christians today have to overcome? What obstacles do you have to overcome?
- [4] 2 Chron 34:14-28 I In these verses we see that the preaching, teaching & study of God's word is essential in the lives of believers. Do you respond to God's word with a tender heart & receptive spirit?
- [5] 2 Chron 34:29-33 I How did Josiah respond to the preaching of the Word? How did others respond?
- [6] 2 Chron 35:1-19 I In this passage we see that Josiah carefully followed the Passover procedure written in the book of Moses. What is the Passover symbolic of?
- [7] 2 Chron 35:20-27 I How did Josiah's life end? Have you humbled yourself before God, God's Word, and God's people?

Sunday, March 8th | "Revival" David's Heart

- [9] 1 Chron 11-14 I What do you see about David's heart & character in chapter 13?
- [10] 1 Chron 15-17 I What does David's prayer in 17:16-27 reveal most about his love for God & his understanding of God?
- [11] 1 Chron 18-21 I What does chapter 21 reveal about the power of repentance? How would you summarize what David learns most about God in chapter 21?
- [12] 1 Chron 22-24 I Notice the command David gives to the nation's leaders in verse 22:19. In what ways is this also the Lord's personal word to you at this time? What are the most important ways for you to heed this command?
- [13] 1 Chron 25-28 I What encouragement for your personal walk with God do you see in verse 28:9? What do you think serving God wholeheartedly means most for you at this time in your life?
- [14] 1 Chron 29 I Reflect on David's prayer in verses 10-19. How does your heart measure up to the standards David refers to in verses 17-19? How is the Lord testing your own heart at this time?

Sunday, March 15th | "Revival" David's Heart

- [16] 1 Chron 28:9; 2 Chron 1-3 I What charge does David give Solomon? How does Solomon's reign begin?
- [17] 2 Chron 4-7 I God indicated His pleasure with the temple & that His presence would abide there. He offered Solomon a choice in 7:17-22. What was that choice?
- [18] 2 Chron 8-9 I What observation does the queen of Sheba a foreigner make about God & His people in 9:8? How do you think she came to this conclusion?
- [19] Ex 34:16; I Kings 11 I What led to Solomon's divided heart?
- [20] Solomon's legacy is full of contrary themes. What can you learn about Who God is from the life of Solomon? What can you learn from Solomon's life?
- [21] Revelation 3:15-16 I How is your heart? Do you have a whole heart or a half-heart for God?

Sunday, March 22nd | 2 Chronicles "Revival" 2 Chronicles 14-16

- [23] 2 Chron 14 I What is the difference between a revival and a reformation? In Asa's case, which came first?
- [24] 2 Chron 14 I Asa was a great man of prayer. What is the key phrase repeated frequently during Asa's revival? What does this phrase mean?
- [25] 2 Chron 15 I What personal encouragement & exhortation for your own walk with God do you find in the words of the prophet Azariah to King Asa & the people in 2 Chronicles 15:2?
- [26] 2 Chron 15 I Revival requires a knowledge of God's Word. The people were turning to God & seeking Him with all their heart and soul. Can that be said of you? Of our Nation?
- [27] 2 Chron 16 I What personal encouragement for your own walk with God do you see in the words of the prophet Hanani to King Asa in 2 Chronicles 16:9?
- [28] 2 Chron 16 I What happened to Asa at the end of his life? Why? What did Asa use rather than "seeking God's face"? What is the warning in the demise of the king?

Sunday, March 29th | Nehemiah "Revival"

- [30] Neh 1 I Why do you think Nehemiah asked God to remember His promises? Review 2 Chron 7:14. What does this conditional promise reveal about God? Whose sin did Nehemiah confess & what was that sin?
- [31] Neh 2 I According to the first eight verses of chapter 2, what was the "success" for which Nehemiah had prayed in 1:11? What connections between prayer & action do verses 1-8 show?
