WEEK 4




Sunday, March 17th

- [18] Luke 21:1-4 | Summarize what Jesus reveals about Himself and His opponents through His words and deeds in 19:45-21:4.
- [19] Luke 21:5-9 | Jesus again prophesies about the destruction of Jerusalem, but says, “Do not be terrified.” How has following Jesus given you greater peace in light of the destruction in the world around you?
- [20] Luke 21:10-24 | Why does ‘the world’ hate Jesus and His followers (v.17)? What should our response be when we are hated?
- [21] Luke 21:25-28 | Read Rev. 19:11-16. How do you feel when you read this description of Jesus?
- [22] Luke 21:29-38 | Jesus says His words will not pass away. What comfort does this give you?
- [23] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus & how to follow Him?

WEEK 5

Sunday, March 24th

- [25] Luke 18:1-43 | When are you tempted to give up praying? How does the parable in v.1-8 encourage you not to lose heart?
- [26] Luke 19:1-48 | Read v.10. If this was Jesus’ priority, how should that impact your life?
- [27] Luke 20:1-47 | Why do you think Jesus chooses not to give the Jewish leaders a direct answer, but replies with a question of His own (v.4)? What can we learn from His example?
- [28] Luke 21:1-37 | As we have journeyed through Luke, Jesus has continually taught on the godly use of money and possessions. How would you summarize what He has taught?
- [29] In Luke 22 we will be moving away from the life and teaching of Jesus and toward His betrayal, death, and resurrection. As you reflect on what has happened in Luke so far, what stands out to you the most about Jesus?
- [30] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus & how to follow Him?

WEEK 1

Sunday, February 24th

- [Mar 1] Luke 18:18-30 | Why does Jesus say it is hard for the rich to enter the Kingdom of God?
- [2] Luke 18:31-43 | The blind man was healed because of his faith and persistence. What is an area of your life that you need to be persistent in faithfully taking it to Jesus?

WEEK 2

Sunday, March 3rd

- [4] Luke 19:1-10 | What do Zacchaeus’ actions at the end of the story show us about true repentance?
- [5] Luke 19:11-27 | Jesus has given us all work to do until he comes. What is the work he has given you and how will you steward it?
- [6] Luke 19:28-40 | What was Jesus proclaiming about Himself by the way He entered Jerusalem? (Zech. 9:9-13). Spend time praising Jesus for the truth that He is our Messiah King!
- [7] Luke 19:41-44 | How does Jesus feel about Jerusalem’s well-deserved destruction? Ask God to give you this kind of compassion.
- [8] Luke 19:45-48 | Think about Luke 19:46 and in your own words explain what Jesus found wrong with the religion being practiced in the temple.
- [9] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus & how to follow Him?

WEEK 3

Sunday, March 10th

- [11] Luke 20:1-8 | Jesus was constantly having his authority challenged by the Pharisees. How does their challenge reveal a lack of understanding of who Jesus is?
- [12] Luke 20:9-18 | What does this interchange have to do with the leaders’ challenge in v.1-8?
- [13] Luke 20:19-26 | What does it look like for us to “Give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar” in our modern context?
- [14] Luke 20:27-40 | When we think about heaven, how can we make some of the mistakes we read about in this passage? What is it about heaven that should encourage and excite us as Christians?
- [15] Luke 20:41-47 | Jesus gives a warning to those in power who are missing the heart of God. Are there any areas in your life where you may not be living with the right motivations? Pray and ask the Lord to show you.
- [16] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus & how to follow Him?
