We love being able to share God's message with your family in Journey Kids on Sundays and feel our secondary voice of faith for your child is significant, but we also believe God has given **you** the most impactful voice to share his truth and hope with your children. Please use the ideas below as a guide to share God's story with your child while we are unable to meet in person.

WHAT TO DO:

Play "Be the Expert"

- Take turns choosing a topic your child could be an "expert" about: sports, food, fictional characters, Legos, video games, princesses, animals, etc.
- Go back and forth sharing one fact about the selected topic until one partner's knowledge is exhausted. Whoever shares the most facts without repeating wins.
- Say, "We know a lot about some of these things but there is something we can never stop learning about: God! In our Bible story today we'll see how there is always more to discover about God. Let's watch it together!"

• Play "Sink or Float"

- Gather a container and fill it with several inches of water.
- Find a variety of items around your house and write down guesses about whether each item would sink or float in the water.
- Take turns putting each item in the water and seeing who guessed correctly
- Engage in healthy debate about who was right and who was wrong
- o Read 1 Peter 5:5
- Say, "God gets frustrated when people show selfish pride and won't admit they
 are wrong, but shows grace and forgiveness to those who are humble and willing
 to admit they are wrong or have made a mistake.

- Ask for help to keep learning more about God and following his ways
