Hello, Toddler & 4-Kindergarten Room families!

We miss you! We love being able to share God's message with your family in Journey Kids on Sundays and feel our secondary voice of faith for your child is significant, but we also believe God has given **you** the most impactful voice to share his truth and hope with your children. Please use the ideas below as a guide to have fun sharing God's story with your child while we are unable to meet in person.

WHAT TO DO:

- **Play "Around Town"**
 - Use toy cars/trucks/motorcycles/horses/princess carriages, etc. to "drive" around "town" and talk about all the places your family (in a non-quarantine world!) usually goes.
 - An "around town" style rug or mat would work great if you have one. If not, just pretend! Couch = grocery store, chair = park, TV = Gma's house, etc.
 - Say, "In today's Bible story Jesus tells us to go everywhere and tell everyone a special message. Let's watch it together and see!"
- **Watch the Bible Story video**

- **Play "Funny Voice Verse"**
 - Have fun saying this month's memory verse in as many fun voices as possible:
 - high/low
 - fast/slow
 - baby/granny
 - robot/singing
 - Verse: "I am alive for ever and ever." Revelation 1:18
 - Motions:
 - "I am alive" = point both hands up
 - "for ever and ever!" = twirl around
 - Revelation 1:18 = open hands like a book
 - Say, "I love learning God's words from the Bible! That was so fun!"
- **Pray**
 - Thank God for giving us Jesus.
 - Ask God to help your family tell everyone everywhere about Jesus.
