- 2. A building with a purpose to help the community
- 3. 3 more networks started in local communities.
- 4. 2 more sites along US 31
- 5. Give away 15% of general budget
- 6. Kenya impact spreads to the community around the House of Hope Orphanage
- 7. Kids/Teens Raising the next generation of leaders
- 8. See more people go from no connection with God to helping others connect with God
- 9. Resources to match the vision
- 10. More people who own & live out the mission

Let's continue to pray for God to do more than we can imagine in the next 10 years.

GOALS FOR THIS YEAR

To begin some steps towards the dreams for next 10 years, we shared some goals for this year:

- 1) We want more people to connect with Jesus in relationships, not religion. The goal is to see 700 people attend The Journey on a regular basis as we invest and invite.
- 2) We want to share God's love by making a greater impact in the community. Our goal is to serve 2000 hours in the community through our Networks as we look beyond ourselves.
- 3) We want to do life together and take steps to make Jesus the center of our lives. Our goal is to see 100 different people in Journey Night Classes as they learn how to take steps in relationships, not religion.
