

### A \$20K THANKS

This summer we had two \$10,000 challenges issued to our church. Our fiscal year runs from April through March. We had a slow start this new year and a generous donor issued a two-part challenge. Our budget is set for maximum impact and the challenges were designed to help jump start our current situation and address our giving long-term.

Part one of the challenge was in June and July. If our giving was \$10,000 over the normal monthly giving, it would be matched. We went over by \$12,000. So the donor went over and matched the \$12,000 too!

Part two of the challenge was with our auto-giving options. For every person that signed up for auto-giving or intentionally increased their auto-giving amount, the donor would give \$200 per person, up to 50 people. This amounts to another \$10,000. We had almost 40 people take this step!

So to everyone who gives to make The Journey a reality, thank you. To everyone who gave extra for the first challenge or signed up for auto-giving, thank you. Thank you for giving to the mission because it helps people experience relationships, not religion along the lakeshore and beyond!
