GETTING MARRIED AT THE JOURNEY

If you're planning to be married by a member of The Journey staff you will need to complete the pre-marital mentoring program established by The Journey before your wedding date. This process will generally take between 4-6 months.

THE 4 - 6 SESSION PRE-MARITAL MENTORING PROGRAM WILL INCLUDE:

2 meetings with a mentor couple or Pastor (one "get to know you meeting" & one to review the first part of the curriculum).

An initial meeting with the Pastor performing your ceremony.

EITHER choosing 1 of 2 one-day seminars at The Journey for engaged or soon-to-be engaged couples, or attending either a Family Life marriage conference or Winning at Home 2-1 pre-marriage conference, or individual meetings with the Pastor performing your ceremony.

After the seminar day or the marriage conference, you will have a follow-up meeting with either the mentor couple or the Pastor performing your ceremony.

You will also have 1-2 meetings with the Pastor performing your ceremony to discuss and plan the details of your wedding ceremony. These can be combined with mentoring meetings.

The one day Journey Seminar will include: Finances & budgeting, communication, spiritual connection, and sex & intimacy. It will include time to breakout and talk with your future spouse and also a panel of our marriage mentors. Lunch is also provided. Cost for the one day seminar will be \$25.00 per/couple.

YOUR SPECIAL DAY

If you are having a wedding at The Journey building, there are some fees and policies that you need to be aware of:

BUILDING USAGE FEE: If using The Journey for your wedding there is a \$250 fee for attenders and \$500 for non-attenders.

Please request a building usage form from the office or download at the journey cc. com.

We do not allow weddings to be performed after 3pm on Saturdays, if using The Journey building. All events need to be done by 5pm.

PERFORMING PASTOR FEE: for leading the pre-marital counseling, seminars & preparation for the ceremony including rehearsal and the ceremony itself there is a **\$300** flat fee for attenders and **\$500** for non-attenders due two weeks before the wedding. If you are having a destination wedding, travel expenses including gas & hotel must be provided and discussed with the performing Pastor in advance.

We encourage you to personally ask the Pastor you would like to perform your ceremony. Please note, however, that we often cannot guarantee our availability until much closer to your wedding date.

We always will advise you to have a backup Pastor available for that date as well. Our first responsibilities are to our own families and to the mission of The Journey and therefore events that require us on those dates need to take precedence. We will however reserve your date and schedule around it where possible.

We encourage you not to delay. The above meetings are required and we can't make exceptions because you got started too late. We're excited for you as you prepare for your big day!
