



THE OAKS COMMUNITY CHURCH

Is it possible for a church to be the answer to Jesus' prayer, instead of the reason for it?

The Oaks Community Church exists to be the answer to His prayer. This means we want to be a church that loves God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. We want to be a church that makes a significant difference in the lives of our neighbors.

The Oaks will be launching in the Burlington, NC area in August of 2026. The Burlington area is a strategic location because of its growing population and the many nations that are represented there. Also, its proximity to Elon University and offers a unique opportunity to reach the nations represented by the student body.

We want to see that the lost are saved, the saved are sent, and the Church is built. We love God because He loved us first. We desire to demonstrate our love for God by loving our neighbors as Jesus commanded us to, and we believe this is one way to do that.

The Oaks will aim to carry out the Great Commandment and the Great Commission by equipping every generation to reach every generation of *every nation*.

The Oaks is partnering with the Mercy Hill Collaborative and Send NC, who assess and train church planters to be equipped and supported. During this time, Mike Mitchener, the lead pastor, will be closing working with Perkinsville Church in Boone, NC. The role of Perkinsville is to help support and build up The Oaks while also training Mike as a church planter.

THE LEAD PLANTER

We want to go down swinging—living with Kingdom impact until our final breath.

Soon after we became Christians we came to the conclusion that if following Jesus was worth anything, it was worth everything. So, 33 years ago, we sold our house, left the car business, and I enrolled at Piedmont Bible College. Since then, a lot has happened. In 2000, we planted Westside Fellowship with just four families. Today about 400 people attend weekly. More importantly, many people have been called into full-time ministry through Westside during our over 30 years there.

In 2020—during the pandemic—we moved "back home" to Pearisburg, VA to pastor Riverview Baptist Church, the church where I had come to faith. We thought we would retire there, but in August of 2023, the Lord released us for whatever He had next...

God revealed to me at a conference that we were called to plant a church that would be the answer to Jesus' prayer in john 17. We want to raise up "good and faithful servants" who say YES to Jesus no matter what.

Now we obediently answering this call by planting the Oaks Community Church in the Burlington, NC area. Through this church plant we want to see our neighbors loved well, the nations reached, and—most importantly—Christ glorified.











WHY THE BURLINGTON AREA?

Burlington is a rapidly growing area in North Carolina. In the past few years it has exploded in population. We hope to reach every nation that is represented in the Burlington area.

Top 3 reasons our neighbors don't Participate in religious community:

- 1. Moved from previous community
- 2. Did not feel welcomed
- 3. They feel that religious people are judgmental

Another reason the Burlington area is a strategic location is because of it's proximity to Elon University. For one, many nations are represented by the transfer students that are on Elon's campus. Most of these students will leave after graduation and we want them to be sent with Kingdom purpose. Secondly, we want to help lead the younger generation well. College is such a crucial, pivotal times in many lives and we want to meet these students with the gospel.
