- D A Y 2 Pray our hearts would be broken for the lost around the world. *Acts 1:8*
- D A Y 3 Pray that we would be light to a dark world. *Acts 13:47*
- D A Y 4 Pray that all the world would hear the Gospel. *Rom. 10:13-14*
- D A Y 5 Pray God's Word would be translated into every tongue and language in the world. *Hab. 2:14*
- D A Y 6 Pray soon there would be no remaining "unreached people groups" in the world. *Ps. 22:27*
- D A Y 7 Pray that Christ's church, including The Trails, would be a testimony to all nations. *Matt. 24:14*
- D A Y 8 Pray that we would earnestly and prayerfully long for the salvation of others.

- D A Y 9 Pray that we would feel the urgency of our mission. *Matt. 10:7-8*
- D A Y 10 Pray that we would count even our lives as nothing compared to the joy of serving Christ. *Acts 20:24*

- D A Y 4 Pray that we would grow in encouraging one another and building each other up. *1 Thess. 5:11*
- D A Y 5 Pray that we would be marked by boldness and faithfulness in proclaiming the gospel. *Eph. 6:18-19*
- D A Y 6 Pray that we have greater knowledge of His will so that our joy may be strengthened. *Col. 1:9*
- D A Y 7 Pray that our knowledge of Christ's love increases. *Eph. 3:14, 18*
- D A Y 8 Pray that we persevere in our faith. *Luke 22:32*
- D A Y 9 Pray that we live in unity together. *Eph. 4:1-3*
- D A Y 10 Pray that we have protection from temptation and anything that would be an obstacle to our faith. *Matt. 6:13*

- D A Y 1 Pray that we would remember that salvation is not earned. it is a free gift!

- D A Y 2 Pray that we would trust that none of our suffering is punishment from God.
Rom. 8:1
- D A Y 3 Pray that we would understand the magnitude of the righteousness that we have obtained. *2 Cor. 5:21*
- D A Y 4 Pray that God would help us to see the full scope of His plan of redemption.
Rom. 8:20-24
- D A Y 5 Pray a prayer of thanksgiving to God that He chose us to be his sons and daughters. *Eph. 1: 4-6*
- D A Y 6 Pray that we would remember that God first loved us. *1 John 4:10*
- D A Y 7 Pray a prayer of confession and meditate on the fact that your sins are forgiven. *Rom. 10:9-10*
- D A Y 8 Pray that we would remember the suffering of Christ on the Cross.

- D A Y 9 Pray that we would be bold in our faith. *Rom. 1:16, Eph. 3:12*
- D A Y 10 Pray a prayer of celebration, that although we have fallen short...He has not!

- D A Y 1 Pray that we never tire of meeting together and we make it a priority to spur each other on in our faith. *Heb. 10:24-25*
- D A Y 2 Pray that we never forget that we belong to one another and we form one body. *Rom. 12:4-5*
- D A Y 3 Pray that we live in pleasant unity with one another. *Ps. 133:1*
- D A Y 4 Pray that we be of the same mind in Christ and that we are committed to serve without divisions in our body. *1 Cor. 1:10*
- D A Y 5 Pray that we always remember God is tangibly present when we meet together. *Matt. 18:20*
- D A Y 6 Pray that our body has the mind of Christ, shows sympathy and love for one another, and lives humbly with tender hearts towards all. *1 Pet. 3:8*
- D A Y 7 Pray that we become a diverse body of believers that serves as equals in Christ.
Rom. 12:16
- D A Y 8 Pray that our body never tires of worshipping and breaking bread with one another, and becomes known for its generous heart. *Acts 2:46-47*
- D A Y 9 Pray that we honor God by living in harmony with each member of our church family. *Rom. 15:5*
- D A Y 10 Pray that we rejoice in our adoption by God and that we are no longer a slave to sin and fear. *Rom. 8:15*
