
PARTICIPANTS IN BIBLE STUDIES





As a people who have been transformed by the message of the gospel, we encourage church members to take the Great Commission personally and to be effective partners in discipling neighbors in our community and among the nations. In addition to supporting church planting and missions partners financially, we are also committed to serving our local communities.

This year, we partnered with Cornerstone to provide 40 backpacks filled with school supplies to local children in need. We also partnered with Embrace Texas to serve the foster and adoptive community of Collin County with financial gifts and support. Partnering with 25 Project in November, we sent three members to South Asia to continue our mission of making the gospel known among the nations.

Our church campus will establish a permanent base for gospel ministry that fosters community with a variety of gathering spaces, both indoors and outdoors, including:

A new 600 seat worship center that will give us plenty of seating for Sunday morning worship services and also serve our weekly youth gatherings and offer flexible space for fellowship events throughout the week

A two-story children's area that will provide a safe and secure environment for Trails Kids to grow and thrive

A lobby and back patio that will be an inviting space for our people to gather and connect with one another

A renovated admin building that will not only house our offices, but will provide flexible meeting spaces for fellowship and learning
