



THE GLORIOUS GOSPEL OF GOD • ROMANS 1:2-4

Romans 1:2-4 includes a brief introduction to “The Glorious Gospel of God.” The good news that reached Paul is the good news he now longs to share, so that the gospel might gladden our hearts and set us singing, dancing, and leaping for joy. We will organize our thoughts under four headings: the source of the gospel, the promise of the gospel, the message of the gospel, and the heart of the gospel.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. *Shaping Question: When was the last time the gospel was truly good news to you?*
2. What is the source of the gospel? How can we experience a fresh beholding of God as we dive into the message of the gospel?
3. How has the promise of the gospel been foretold even back to the earliest pages of Scripture? How has this promise been affirmed in the New Testament?
4. What does it mean to call Jesus your Lord? How do we live in a way that reflects Christ’s Lordship in our own lives?
