



Today, we pause before turning the page to Acts 4 and revisit three verses from our passage last week. We center our attention on “The Gospel of Repentance.” We see this proclaimed in Acts 3:19-21 as we seek a twin aim: to understand the basics of repentance and revel in the blessings it brings.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were the three basics of repentance that Matt highlighted in his sermon? Discuss these “turnings” together as a group. What do they look like in the life of a Christian?
2. Read aloud from Colossians 3:1-17. How does Paul give us a picture of repentance in these verses?
3. What are the three blessings of repentance that Peter mentions in this text in Acts? Discuss these blessings together as a group. What do they look like in the life of a Christian?
4. Shaping Question: What role does repentance play in your life?

PRAY: If appropriate, use this time as a group to confess sin and repent together in prayer. Ask that the Holy Spirit would search your heart and help make known to you sins for which you need to repent. Pray that the Lord would bring times of refreshing to you personally, to your group, and to The Trails Church overall.
