DEVOTED TO WORSHIP • ACTS 2:42-47



At the center of the characteristics found in Acts 2:42-47 is a church "Devoted to Worship." The early church practiced a rhythm of worship as they grew in doctrine and devotion to Christ. They gathered to worship, to encourage, and to proclaim the mighty works of God together. As we look to their example, we find rhythms of worship from Scripture that we aspire to know and grow in as a church. We see how the church *Gathered to Worship*, we detail the *Acts of Worship*, and, finally, we see the impact of their *Evangelistic Worship*.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How has your life been transformed and shaped by the worship of Christ?

2. What are the two ways in which Matt mentioned the church in Acts is gathered? What kind of rhythms have we created as a church to gather to worship the Lord?

3. What are the three acts of worship that Matt said are found in the early church's worship? How does our worship service reflect these acts of worship?

4. Is there an act of worship we need to grow in together as a family of believers? Or one you'd like to grow in personally?

5. Discuss how we at The Trails organize our Sunday worship service around the gospel of Jesus. Look at the bulletin. How does the flow of our service model the gospel?

PRAY: Ask the Lord to give you greater delight in Jesus, that your life would be marked by worshipping him. Pray for our church's worship services, that The Trails would be a place that makes much of Jesus each time we gather.
