



DEVOTED TO THE FELLOWSHIP • ACTS 2:42-47

Acts 2:42-47 presents a flourishing vision for biblical community. One of the primary characteristics of New Testament Christianity is God-focused, Christ-given, Spirit-enabled fellowship with other believers. Our faith comes with a family. We can look at this early snapshot of the church and learn what it looks like to be “Devoted to the Fellowship.” There are three realities to this fellowship that are important to understand: *Commitment of the Church*, *The Community of the Church*, and *Commission of Church*.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In what ways are you devoted to Biblical community?
2. Christians have both fellowship with God and with each other. How does your fellowship with other Christians strengthen your fellowship with God?
- 3.. What did the community of the church look like in Acts 2:42-47? (Answer: Learning, Loving, Worshiping, Evangelistic). Which of these four elements do you hope to grow in as a Christian?
4. Matt noted that the commission of the Christian church is to be growing and going. What are you doing with all that you’re learning about Jesus? (i.e. how does our growing contribute to our going?)

PRAY: Ask that the Lord would strengthen and deepen the roots of your community group, that you would grow in your fellowship with each other and with the Lord.
