



INCARNATION • GALATIANS 4:4-7

The truths of Galatians 4:4-7 offer a lifetime fruitful study. Here the Apostle Paul outlines that the coming of Christ was neither early or late but came to pass according to God's eternal plan and purpose. These verses reveal what uniquely qualified Jesus to bring such a great salvation and speak of the benefits that flow to us through him. Our Advent exploration of this text begins where the Apostle himself does, with "Incarnation."

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Does the incarnation of Christ still cause amazement in your heart?
2. Discuss as a group how God's plan to send his son was carried out patiently and eternally.
3. Reflect on your own lives—how have you seen God's perfect timing play out in your own story?
4. What does it mean that Jesus is fully human? What hope do we have as Christians because of this truth?
5. What does it mean that Jesus is fully God? What hope do we have as Christians because of this truth?

PRAY: Spend a moment in prayer worshiping God for his perfect providential timing and for the incarnation. Ask that the Lord would give you a fresh anticipation of and longing for Christ's return as we enter into this advent season of waiting.
