Colossians 1:28 is just one verse, but it's a wonderful summary of Paul's ministry to the church. More than just a descriptive passage about Paul's life and ministry, it also contains a prescriptive call for all of us who are in Christ to join Paul in saying, "Him We Proclaim."

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are the core truths of the gospel that you would want a lost friend to know?
2. Max talked about living in our lives in such a way that it wouldn't be unusual for us to talk about faith in casual conversation. What are some specific ways, however big or small, that you could do that in your everyday life?
3. What are the biggest challenges or hang-ups that keep you from discipling others?
4. Think of struggles that you or other Christians that you know have gone through—how would pointing them to a truth about Christ or a teaching of Christ have helped them?
5. On a piece of paper, write down the circles of people who make up your "community" (draw circles for different groups of people in your life—family, friends, church family, work, neighbors, etc.—and then make stems off of those with names of individuals who belong to those circles). These are all people that God has placed in your life and, in varying capacities, in your sphere of influence.
 - a. Who among these is lost and could be helped by your prayers and your faithful witness?
 - b. Consider 1-2 Christian brothers/sisters from this. In what ways could you help them follow Jesus this week and do them deliberate spiritual good?
