

TASTE AND SEE • EXODUS 25:23-30

In Exodus 25:23-30 we find instructions for the "Table of the Bread of Presence," the second most holy piece of furniture found in the Tabernacle. It was at this table of remembrance that God set before his people a continual reminder of his provision in their lives. It was also here that God showed Israel a palpable expression of the everlasting covenant he had made with them at Mount Sinai – to be their God and for them to be his people. The invitation of this memorial table was to *Taste and See* the offering it held and to be reminded of two specific truths: *God Provides for His People*, and *God is Present With His People*.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Read Exodus 25:23-30. What is the main idea of this text? What stands out to you?
- 2. What did God's table, set with food, suggest to us in the context of worship? What does the Lord's Table, set with food, suggest to us today?
- 3. In what ways did God's people experience fellowship with him? How is this similar to and different from our fellowship with God under the New Covenant?
- 4. What comforts can we draw from this passage?

Pray that our church would hunger to know the Lord and grow in our practice of fellowship with him.
