Training Depot's Policy for Health Safety

Our cleaning crew & teachers clean daily disinfecting our classrooms & center.
See below for our daily guidelines:

OPENING: We are opening & closing at our normal times of 6am to 6pm.

ENTERING & SANITIZING: During times of covid or contagious diseases resurgence, if deemed necessary, we will ask parents to wear a mask when entering our building and teachers will be asked to wear a mask when leaving their classroom. Hand sanitizer dispensers are located throughout the TD hallway. Every child and staff person will wash their hands upon entering the classroom as well as several designated times throughout the day. The coaches & teachers for our extra classes of Soccer Shots are required to follow the same procedures as our staff. They will also clean and sanitize between every group of children that come to them. Teachers will be asked to wear masks during transition times if deemed necessary. During times when covid is not a huge issue and we are not having to quarantine multiple children on a regular basis, we will operate as normal without masks.

WORKING TOGETHER & HELPING KEEP EACH OTHER SAFE: We are in close contact with the Center for Disease Control, our TX Health & Human Resources Reps, as well as our Childcare Licensing Rep. to make sure we have a clear understanding of all the guidelines recommended to help ensure the safety of everyone connected with our center. According to CCR, as of now, we are able to resume normal classroom sizes as per State Standards.

If a teacher has concerns about a child, their temperature will be taken throughout our school day. If a child begins to run fever during the day, parents will be called & will need to come pick up their child immediately. Then the child will be able to return when they have been fever free for 24 hours. The 24 hour period is determined in this manner: example – If the child is sent home at 9am on a Tuesday, the child will NOT be able to return on Wednesday at all. As long as the child is fever free ALL day on Wednesday, with no fever-reducing medicine, the child may return on Thursday. Cases of diarrhea & vomiting will follow our normal procedures which is 2 episodes of either of these, then the child will need to go home & can return 24 hours later as long as they are symptom free. If a child is having a severe cough, they will not be able to attend for the day & can only return after the severe cough is gone. If your child is experiencing an excessive runny nose, shortness of breath or a sore throat, please keep them home for at least 24 hours or as long as your doctor deems necessary if longer than 48 hours. **If anyone in your immediate household is Covid positive or is showing signs of any contagious diseases, please be cautious about sending your child to school. If you and/or your child are being tested for Covid, please keep your child home until you have received the test results.**
