3. Respond to a gracious savior (vs. 5-7)


# ABOUT THE LORD'S SUPPER AT TRINITY

The Lord's Supper, also called Communion, is a time for Christians to meet with the Savior to be strengthened in our faith. We invite those who are baptized members of an evangelical church to participate.

As part of our worship service, we come forward to the table by using the center aisles. Take one of the double stacked cups that contain bread on the bottom and grape juice on the top. Gluten free communion bread is labeled and located in the center tray on the table. Return to your seat using the outside aisles and join in singing.

Children who have not yet publicly professed their faith in Christ should refrain from participating in communion. Trinity has resources to help assist you in the process of your child becoming a communing member and participating in communion.


