James 2:14-26 (10-11-20: Faith Without Works Is No Faith)

Intro: What does it mean to be nominal? – Name but not behavior to match.

- Integration – Parts function as a whole, where have you experienced integration or integrity?

WHAT IS OUR BASELINE?

Why does it matter that the LORD is a God of integrity?

The heavenly beings shout together, "Worthy are you, our Lord and God to receive glory, and honor and power, for you created all things and by your will they existed and were created."

What is it about God that makes him worthy and we are not worthy? What disqualifies you?

SIN AS DISINTEGRATION - What is wrong here?

Where are you dis-integrated? Which of your relationships are disintegrating? Why? Pray. Ask.

JUSTIFICATION & SANCTIFICATION

How does true faith in Jesus result in comprehensive change?

What do you gain from the work of Jesus on the Cross? - (Our Forgiveness)

What do we gain from is life of perfection? (Our Righteousness – we become adoptable)

What do we gain in His Resurrection? The Confirmation and Approval of God in the Work of Jesus?
