## Worship: Worship God for Inventing – Words and Prayer (10 min)

God is so cool. Sight connects us with creation. Words connect us to people, their hearts and ours. Worship God the brilliance in His inventions of seeing, hearing, and speaking. Then after giving us the tools to engage He invites, commends and commands us to engage with Him, Father, Jesus and Holy Spirit and with our neighbor in confession and love.

Read the following passages. Pause after each set of verses to worship God for His wondrous works in His Creation.

**Luke 11:2** And he said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. 3 Give us each day our daily bread, 4 and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation..."

**Luke 11:9–13** And I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. 11 What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent; 12 or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? 13 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

**Revelation 5:11-14** <sup>11</sup> Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, <sup>12</sup> saying with a loud voice,

"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"

"To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!"
