Themes: Advent, Disruption, War, Impossible, Hope,

- The result of Christmas is that sinners are made worshippers and rebels transformed into loyal children.
- **Good News**: God has done the impossible in the pregnancy of Mary with Jesus, baby God, and in Jesus has provided the solution to the problem of US and evil.
- **Bad News**: we hate the disruption of God's ownership, rule, and the demands of God's solution.
- The Hopeful Turn: God does the impossible all the time, the conversion of our souls
 - o by His love, He sent His Son,
 - o to His love, He gives Holy Spirit to live in us,
 - o and through His love, we now love others with the love He has given us.

Text: Luke 1:26-38 (ESV)

Title: Eternal Hope In The Midst of War: The Disruption of Christmas, Teacher: Tim Rice ²⁶ In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, ²⁷ to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ And he came to her and said, "Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!" ²⁹ But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of gree0ng this might be. ³⁰ And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. ³² He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, ³³ and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." 34 And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?" 35 And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God. ³⁶ And behold, your rela0ve Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. ³⁷ For nothing will be impossible with God." ³⁸ And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.
