

Facilitator – The Humble King: Immanuel, Matt 13:31-32, Bud Daniel

1. **Launchers: Do you have an “I’ve got this” moment? How did that turn out?**

2. **Worship God: Read Philippians 2:3-11**

- Worship God, the Father, for loving us so much that he sent His Son.
- Worship God, the Son Jesus, for working salvation for us by crushing evil.
- Worship God, Holy Spirit, for giving us eyes to see and hearts for feel our need and believe.

3. **Sermon Reflection: The Humble King: Immanuel, Eze: 17-22-24, Matt. 13:31-32**

- What has been accomplished through the humility of Jesus?
- The “system” in the Bible is consistent. Israel’s prideful, there are consequences, and yet God never forsakes his people. Instead, we receive grace upon grace.
- The Lord Himself delivers us from our pride and judgement in the most scandalous way. He takes the seemingly insignificant and makes it of utmost significance.
- **Application:**
 - If Jesus has accomplished so much through humility, now what for us?
 - We re-live the wonder of the Gospel all the time by confessing and believing in the power of Christ.

4. **Kingdom Centered Prayer:**

1. Worship the LORD for His goodness and mercy on us, a proud people. Thank Father, Son, and Holy Spirit for the way that He has incarnated with us and delivered us from separation from Him.
2. Confess your arrogance to Jesus for thinking you know better than Him, asking Him to forgive you and heal you from your pride.
3. Give thanks to Jesus for His character and the beauty in what He values. He is a savior who loves, cherishes humility, and who provides dignity and grace to the lowly.
4. Who in your life has an “I got this” attitude”? Pray for them, that they would put their hope and dependency in Jesus; and that Holy Spirit would show you how you struggle with the same thing.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to imbed in your heart and the hearts of this city, a posture of humility. Ask for a humility that is sourced by the wonder and magnificence of who Jesus is and what He has accomplished for us.
