- Think of how great it is that God prepares us for the Gospel Cry for help by giving us difficulties that move us to need help from our neighbors.
- What do think of those folks who came to your aid? How do you remember them?

- What were the circumstances? How old were you?
- What would it be like to have a "Cry Out to God" time scheduled every week/weak?
- How often to you cry out to God and for whom and about what?

With God there is forgiveness!

• Where would you rank forgiveness in all of God's inventions or qualities?

- What person has forgiven you the most both in worst thing you have done and most offenses also?
- How come it is easier to believe God can forgive the World of their sin rather than forgive you of your sin?
- How is your life different or how would it be different if you knew that you knew that you knew that you knew that God had forgiven you all your sins?
- Knowing God has forgiven you of everything, how does that affect how you think about Him?

5. Mission: Christians, folks on mission to love

- This is a great, great week to go on a love offensive. So think through your week and pray for each person each day that will be tough for you to love.
- Pray for your friends who are nervous and godless.
- Pray they would turn to Jesus, believe and rest on him alone as he is offered for you in the Gospel.
